Representing Lafarge Africa as a key speaker, Emmanuel Ilaboya, Head of Innovation and New Product Development, delivered a presentation titled, 'Leadership in Sustainable Construction Solutions.'

He provided an overview of the company's mission and industry leadership, stating: "Lafarge Africa is not just a cement manufacturer. We are a complete building solutions company, driving sustainability and operational excellence through continuous innovation."

He emphasised that Lafarge Africa operates with a larger purpose, leading the charge toward a greener planet and sustainable construction practices.

llaboya highlighted Lafarge Africa's four major business segments: Cement, ReadyMix, Aggregates and Products and Solutions, which deliver high-performance solutions across the country.
